Section 1. Section 81-885.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1

is amended to read:

81-885.03 (1) Any person who, directly or indirectly for another, with the intention or upon the promise of receiving any form of 4 compensation or consideration, offers, attempts, or agrees to perform or 5 performs any single act described in subdivision (2) of section 6 81-885.01, whether as a part of a transaction, or as an entire 7 transaction, shall be deemed a broker, associate broker, or salesperson 8 within the meaning of the Nebraska Real Estate License Act, and such 9 action shall constitute sufficient contact with the state for the 10 exercise of personal jurisdiction over such person in any action arising 11 out of such action. Committing a single act described in such subdivision 12 by a person required to be licensed under the Nebraska Real Estate 13 License Act and not so licensed shall constitute a violation of the act 14 for which the commission may impose sanctions pursuant to this section 15 for the protection of the public health, safety, or welfare. 16

- (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of the law to the contrary, the director may issue a cease and desist order against any person who violates this section by performing any action described in subsection (1) of this section without the appropriate license. Such order shall be final ten days after issuance unless the violator requests a hearing before the commission pursuant to section 81-885.25.
- (3) If such person violates a cease and desist order issued pursuant to this section, he or she shall be subject to further proceedings before the commission. If, during such proceedings, the commission makes a finding of guilt, the commission may impose a fine not to exceed (a) one thousand dollars for each day that any action is performed without the appropriate license following the issuance of the order or (b) the amount of all money earned as commission by the violator, whichever is greater. Judgments for the collection of any fine imposed under this section may be filed in the district court of any county in this state.

- 1 (4) Notice and hearing requirements under this section shall be in 2 accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act.
- 3 Sec. 2. Section 81-885.25, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 4 amended to read:
- 81-885.25 (1) Before the commission censures a licensee, imposes a 5 civil fine, or revokes or suspends a license, or issues a cease and 6 desist order, the commission shall send to the licensee or violator a 7 copy of the complaint by registered mail, certified mail, first-class 8 mail using intelligent mail barcode or another similar tracking method 9 used or approved by the United States Postal Service, or a designated 10 delivery service as provided in section 25-505.01, which contains the 11 charges against the licensee or violator and, unless the licensee or 12 violator waives the right to a hearing and has executed a consent order, 13 give the licensee or violator a hearing on the matter. 14
- (2) The licensee or violator shall have full authority to be heard 15 in person or by counsel before the commission in reference to such 16 charges. The commission shall, at least twenty days prior to the date set 17 for hearing, notify the licensee or violator in writing of the date and 18 place of the hearing. Such notice may be served by delivering it 19 personally to the licensee or violator or by sending it by either 20 registered mail, certified mail, first-class mail using intelligent mail 21 barcode or another similar tracking method used or approved by the United 22 States Postal Service, or a designated delivery service as provided in 23 section 25-505.01, to the last-known business address of such licensee or 24 any known address of the violator. If the licensee is an associate broker 25 or a salesperson, the commission shall also notify the broker employing 26 the licensee by mailing a copy of such notice to the broker's last-known 27 business address. 28
